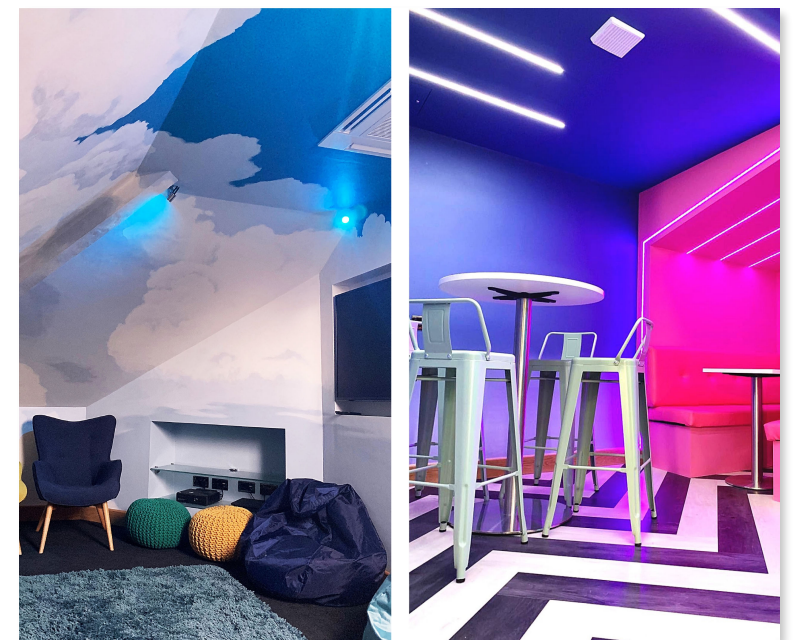


Accommodation, meal plan

DAY 1 – Foundations & Self-Expression

Theme: “Who Am I as an Artist?”



Workshop	Focus	Description
1. Portrait Painting Remix	Acrylic & Mixed Media	Learn proportions and color mixing, then reinterpret portraits using expressive color and collage.
2. Creative Sketchbook Design	Drawing & Journaling	Create a personalized art journal cover and learn daily sketching techniques for idea generation.
3. Cultural Symbols Collage	Collage & Storytelling	Share your cultural background through images, patterns, and symbols in a collaborative wall mural.
4. Experimental Photography	Photography & Composition	Explore light, angle, and perspective; experiment with phone cameras to capture artistic self-portraits.

1. Watercolour Worlds

Painting Techniques

Learn wet-on-wet, salt texture, and layering to create dreamlike landscapes or abstract designs.

2. Clay Creations

3D Art & Sculpture

Hand-build small clay sculptures inspired by natural forms or personal symbols.

3. Digital Illustration

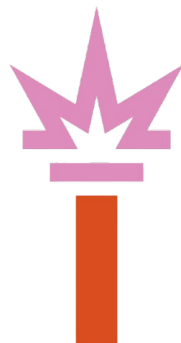
Digital Art

Create block or monoprints using linoleum, foam, or natural textures; explore repetition and pattern.

Create a visual short story using painting, drawing, and text elements.

3. Recycled Sculpture

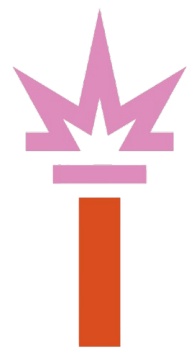
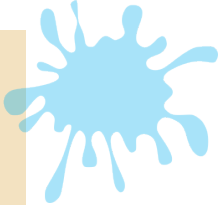
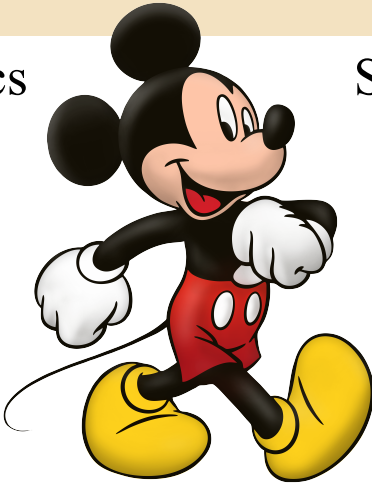
Sustainability & Installation

Collaboratively build sculptures using found/recycled materials, focusing on environmental themes.

4. Animation Basics

Make a short stop-motion film or digital GIF exploring teamwork or identity.

DAY 4 – Team Project.

Theme: “Art as Connection”

Workshop	Focus	Description
1. Exhibition Design	Curating & Presentation	Learn to plan and install your own mini exhibition—title cards, layout, lighting, and storytelling.
2. Art & Emotion	Expressive Techniques	Use music-inspired painting or movement drawing to explore how emotion drives artistic choices.
3. Poster Design for Change	Graphic Design & Social Awareness	Create a poster that communicates a message about unity, sustainability, or creativity.
4. Collaborative Mural	Group Project	Contribute to a large mural representing the camp’s themes—diversity, creativity, and friendship.
